Students not attending Special Religious Education (SRE) or Special Education in Ethics (SEE) are given supervised, alternative activities in Non-Scripture (NS).

On enrolment, parents/carers must select which option they would like for their child.

Changes for SRE/SEE/NS will only be accepted until the end of Week 3, Term 1, via emailing your request to the school (please include your child's name, previous SRE/SEE/NS group and new preference).

Please note, we cannot guarantee that SRE/SEE teachers will be available for every group. This is dependent on the number of volunteer teachers available. If SRE/SEE teachers are not available, students will be given supervised, alternative activities.
